The digitalization of healthcare has enabled health services to be more accessible and available daily. Mrs Taranjot Kaur (Alumni of ACN) explained that the effect of digital technology has been increasing in the nursing sector. New technologies can address specific existing problems: Nurses spend at least 30 % of their working day filling out forms and documenting patient data. Digitalized documentation process reduce paperwork, create optimized schedules and increases productivity, allowing nurses more time for patient care.

She gave some examples of tools and technologies that are used in today's time like Telehealth/ Telemedicine (Beneficial in nursing homes during outbreaks of infectious disease), EHR (Electronic Health Records made nursing documentation easy), Mobile Health (Coaching patients via applications can improve short term outcomes), Personalized care (Treatment tailored to individual patients enables nurses to deliver more personalized care), Social Media and Online information internet (It also helps a lot in the nursing field and in supporting patients & students education), Digital Monitors & Devices like Blood glucose monitors, Pulse oximeters, BP monitors, weighing scales, thermometers (Can be easily used even at home by anyone with adequate knowledge).
