BYE-LAWS

1. Membership

All Nurses applying for membership in the TNAI shall be recommended by the Nursing Superintendent / Principal / Director of Nursing / Principal Tutor or any senior member of TNAI. In case the recommendation from any one of the above-mentioned persons is not possible, then true/ attested copies of Registration Certificates must be sent along with the application form.

Except that, for Nurses transferring from SNA to TNAI, a certificate from the person in-charge of the training school/college authenticating that the student has completed the course successfully along with the attested copy of the final year mark sheet. All registered Nurse Midwives accepted for membership shall be life members of TNAI.

A Nurse eligible for life membership in TNAI shall be a graduate of a School/College of Nursing, recognised by the Registration Council/ Examination Board, and Indian Nursing Council. In the case of foreign qualifications, these should be recognised by the registering body of that country and INC. The certificate of equivalence issued by INC should be submitted.

2. Membership Fee

TNAI membership fee will be as determined by the council from time to time and it will be published in NJI, TNAI Bulletin, TNAI Website and the Membership application form.

NB: Students transferring their membership from SNA to TNAI and availing the concession in life membership should apply immediately on passing the final examination and not later than one year after the announcement of results.

Membership Fee Concession

A concession in membership fee shall be applicable as follows:

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- Members of Student Nurses Association shall be admitted to life membership on the foregoing terms of entrance fees within one year of their completing the training by successfully passing the examination and forwarding their application to the Headquarters. Such members shall pay the Life Membership subscription at the concessional rate.
- b) Religious Sisters drawing no salary and retired nurses are also eligible for Life membership at concessional rate, provided a certificate to this effect to be submitted along with the application form. They shall pay Life membership fee at the concessional rate as decided by the Council from time to time.
- c) All subscriptions except Life membership shall be credited to the General Fund of TNAI.
- TNAI shall make a grant, per capita, as decided by the Council from time to time, to the State Branches. The current rate is 10% of life membership fee per member for the new member and Rs. 5 for existing members.

3. Affiliations

a) Any All-India Association or Society of Nurses seeking affiliation shall make application in writing to the Secretary-General of TNAI enclosing, with the application, copies of the Constitution, Bye-laws, Rules and the Annual Report of such Association or Society. Such application should be signed by the Presiding Officer of the Society, Secretary and one other member of the committee of management. The application shall be considered by the TNAI Council at its next meeting. The Council shall report to the next House of Delegates meeting such affiliations as have been accepted.

At the State level, a local organisation of a State level chapter seeking affiliation with TNAI shall make application to the State Branch concerned who shall recommend the case to the Headquarters along with the Constitution, Rules & Regulations organisation. The request will be considered on the basis of

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similarity of objectives. Such an Association should be registered under the Societies Registration Act. The Headquarters shall arrange further processing of the application at the Executive / Council level. The Headquarters will charge a minimum of Rs. 20/- per member as affiliation fee.

- b) Each affiliated Association or Society of Nurses shall provide definite ruling/resolution in its Bye-laws for the President or Secretary-General or any other representative of TNAI to be on its committees of management. Each affiliated nursing Association shall also elect/nominate a member of TNAI to be its representative on Council who shall have full voting powers. The expenses of attending any meeting shall be borne by the organisation concerned.
- c) The affiliation fee shall be payable on 1st day of each accounting/ financial year (April, 1) and shall be at the rate of Rs. 10/- per annum per member. Only those nursing organisations whose members are individual members of TNAI shall pay at this rate.
- d) On joining the Association a copy of the Constitution, Rules and Regulations, Bye-Laws and a brief resume of the activities of the Association shall be supplied to each member/affiliating organisation.
- e) One copy of the official Journal i.e. *The Nursing Journal of India* and *TNAI Bulletin* shall be supplied by TNAI to each affiliated Association free of cost.
- f) Each affiliated Association shall send its annual Report to the Secretary-General which shall be submitted to the Council and House of Delegates meeting of the TNAI.
- g) Any affiliated Association that may withdraw from affiliation at any time, by written notice to the Council of TNAI.
- h) Any affiliated Association ceases to meet the requirements of affiliation as outlined in the existing Rules and Regulations and Bye-laws if, after investigation and due warnings, it still fails

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to conform to those requirements within 6 months, the Council shall report to the House of Delegates meeting for decision to be taken about the disaffiliation of such organisation.

4. Official Organ

The Nursing Journal of India (NJI) and TNAI Bulletin shall be the official organs of the Association. NJI is a subscribed scientific journal on the rate specified from time to time by the council of TNAI. TNAI Bulletin shall be supplied to all the life members **on request** and for the first year of enrolment to TNAI as complimentary. A copy of the *Nursing Journal of India* shall be supplied on the rates specified from time to time to all the life Members and all other Members who subscribe to the Journal, as decided by the Council. Each SNA unit shall get a minimum of two copies and a maximum of 4 copies of the TNAI Bulletin. Copies shall also be provided as required under Bye-Laws 3(e). Complimentary/free copy to be supplied to the following:

- All the SNA Advisors
- All the affiliated organisations
- State nursing registration councils
- Ex-Presidents of past 4 terms
- Nursing Directorate at State Level
- President and Secretary, INC
- Nursing Advisor to Government of India
- All SNA units based on the membership

5. Duties of Officers

- a) President shall preside over the meetings of the Council and the General Meetings of the association and shall be the chairperson of all committees. President shall approve the agenda of all the meetings and also approve and minutes of all the Meetings. She/of the Association and the decisions made at the different
