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

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| 13. | Explain about personal disorganization | 25 min | <p>objects.</p> <p>*Individualization as a kind of depending into ourselves.</p> <p><u>PERSONAL DISORGANIZATION</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> λ Personal Disorganization represent the behaviour of individual which deviates from the social norms. λ Any various behaviour which disturbs the integration of the attitude system within the personality represents called personal disorganization. λ It means that the individual is out of adjustment with society, who has failed to organize the chief goals of his life. λ It may be mild or violent. λ When the parts of social structure do not perform their functions efficiently and effectively or perform them badly, there occurs an imbalance in society. λ The social equilibrium is disturbed and society gets out of gear because of this personal disorganization. λ For example: alcoholics, criminals, prostitutes and drug addicts etc., who are mentally normal but socially abnormal. | lecture cum discussion | PPT | Students will be able to tell about personal disorganization |
